How did she get to be principal for a day? Easy. The Positive Behaviour for Learning Framework enables students to earn acknowledgement that we refer to as Possums. The students choose how they use the Possums and can trade for a novelty item at the Possum Shop or trade to sit at the teacher's desk for a day. If a student collects 150, they get the opportunity to choose to be principal for a day.

#### **Stage 2 Mathematics**

The students have been learning about multiplying and dividing using arrays! The lesson effectively engaged students in understanding partitioning using arrays to multiply and divide through explicit teaching, hands-on activities, and independent practice, fostering a deep comprehension of the learning intention and success criteria.

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<sup>\*</sup>An annual Government fee relief payment of up to \$2110 is available to 4 year old children who attend an eligible early childhood education program at an approved New South Wales G8 Education centre. To be eligible, the child must be 4 years old by 31 July in the relevant enrolment year and have nominated a G8 Education eligible centre for the enrolment year. To be eligible the child must attend minimum 15 hours of preschool per week. The pro-rated payment is applied monthly (March — December) to a child's fees after any CCS has been applied. Children that discontinue in the program or commence after March in the relevant year will be allocated a pro-rated subsidy based on their departure or commencement date.
